SOIL/EXPOSURE :
Clay-limestone

VINIFICATION :
Hand-harvested in crates. Indigenous yeasts, 15-day maceration, delicate pumping-over similar to infusion. Unfined, unfiltered.

AGEING :
Tank and bottle

TASTING :
Nose of red fruit and pepper. Supple on the palate, with small but ripe tannins. Fruity, juicy...

FOOD AND WINE PAIRING :
Charcuterie, grilled beef pear, raclette...

TOTAL SO₂: <25 mg/L - TAV: 11.5%.

AGING POTENTIAL: 5 to 7 years

Grant WOOD painted American Gothic in 1930 to denounce the poverty of American farmers following the stock market crash of '29... This Aramon was planted in 1927, first vintage in 1930. The two are linked by age and history...
